Then apply with your (also interdisciplinary) concepts for the Gender Diversity Award 2025! Students of all degree programmes, who are regularly enrolled at HMTM, can take part.

Prize

- The prize consists of a project grant of €500 each for up to three project concepts for realisation
- Presentation (poster, pitch, short lecture, performance etc.) as part of the RESPECT Day on 19 November 2025

Procedure

- 1. Submission of application documents by 6 January 2025 to <u>diversity.award@hmtm.de</u>
- 2. Selection of the projects to be funded by the jury (by 17 February 2025)
- 3. Financial reward (grant) for the projects in accordance with the project agreement in up to two instalments (project start, after project completion)
- 4. Implementation of the projects (march 2025 to october 2025)
- 5. Submission of a project report with settlement (31 october 2025)

Application documents

- Application form with brief overview of the project
- Letter of motivation (max. 1800 characters)
- Curriculum vitae (max. 2000 characters)
- Meaningful project description of the planned project (max. 6000 characters)
- Budget plan for the use of the prize money (see template)
- Schedule and planned presentation of the project/submission of the work
- If applicable, link to the recording of a project that has already taken place (not older than one year)

Selection criteria

- The topic is innovative and forward-looking.
- Relevance of the topic with new impulses for artistic, pedagogical or scientific practice and discourse.

Examples of possible topics

- Expansion of the canon/repertoire, taking into account aspects of decolonisation and postcolonial issues
- Gender roles
- Gender, domination and power relations in the arts
- (De)construction of gender in the arts
- Gender identities & (artistic) concepts of diversity
- Art & inclusion
- Examination of artistic approaches/personalities whose work can be categorised as gender, queer, diversity or postcolonial studies.
